- Rev. Bob Moore emcees **No Kings Rallies, with an estimated 10,000 in Princeton** on June 14 & October 18, 2025. Over **1,200 attend No Kings Rally in Trenton** co-sponsored by CFPA on March 28, 2026.
- CFPA conducts **Candidate Briefings on the Climate Emergency and Gun Violence Prevention for four major party candidates** running in hotly contested June 10 NJ Primary for Governor. Those four also completed and returned Candidate Questionnaires, which were used to create a Peace Voter Guide for the six candidates who ran in June Primary, distributed via CFPA's web page electronically.
- CFPA co-sponsors **Commemorations of 80th Anniversary of Atomic Bombings of Hiroshima and Nagasaki** on August 5 at Princeton Public Library and August 9, 2025 at Philadelphia Ethical Society, both had full houses of over 100 attendees!
- **CFPA's Annual Member Gathering** on October 12, 2025, keynoted by Joseph Cirincione, draws full house at Christ Congregation in Princeton.
- **CFPA's 46th Annual Conference & Multifaith Service for Peace** on 11/16/25, co-sponsored by 29 organizations, draws 300 participants!
- **CFPA's Annual Holiday Gathering** with themes of *No New Nuclear Arms Race & No War with Venezuela* is attended by 200 in person or virtually, including substantial number of young adults advocating Climate Superfund Act for NJ, on 12/18/25.
- CFPA Executive Director Rev. Bob Moore chairs, and CFPA co-sponsors, **Annual Multifaith Service honoring the legacy of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, attended by 400** in person or via livestream at Princeton United Methodist Church on January 19, 2026.
- Over 200 attend in person, and 850 virtually on CFPA's YouTube Channel—for total of over 1,000-- **CFPA's Rally vs. War against Venezuela** at Hinds Plaza in Princeton on January 7, 2026.
- Over 200 attend in person, and 200 virtually—for a total of over 400--**CFPA's Rally vs. War with Iran** on February 28, 2026 at Hinds Plaza in Princeton.
- CFPA's **2026 Peace Voter Campaign** conducts **Candidate Briefings** by team of experts and leaders with 11 candidates in NJ Districts 2 and 7; and 1 candidate in PA District 1. **Peace Voter Questionnaires** sent in April 2026, with 12 returned and used as basis for Peace Voter Guides leading up to House Primaries.
- **Lifelong peace scholar Dr. David Cortright** keynotes on *Halting and Reversing the Arms Race: Challenges and Opportunities* at **CFPA's Annual Membership Renewal Gathering** at Unitarian Universalist Congregation of Princeton on April 12, 2026. Nearly 60 attended in-person.
- **CFPA's Annual Member Gathering** on June 14, 2026 draws 75 in-person attendees at Christ Congregation in Princeton to hear keynote address from **peace economy expert, William Hartung**.
