The Coalition for Peace Action (CFPA) has a limited number of tickets for the performance by music icon **Joan Baez** on **Friday, November 11** at **8:00 PM** at world-class **McCarter Theatre, 91 University Place, in Princeton**. All tickets available directly through McCarter are sold out, so **these are the only ones left!**

These tickets are part of a fundraiser for CFPA, so cost is \$75 (\$30 tax deductible) for CFPA members and \$90 (\$45 tax deductible) for non-members. **The post-concert Reception is now full, so remaining tickets entitle purchasers to a seat for the concert only.**

Joan Baez is an iconic folk musician as well as a committed social activist and voice for peace. In 1965, she founded the Institute for the Study of Non-Violence and was heavily involved in the draft resistance movement. She later helped to found Amnesty International USA, and has traveled around Latin America to speak out against human rights abuses. She continues to be involved with the non-violence movement by strongly protesting the Iraq War and supporting peace candidates.
